HOTEL SHUTTLE & PARKING INFO

Shuttle Service to and from Chicago O'Hare Airport:

- Complimentary shuttle service is available around the clock. Scheduled runs begin at 4:00 A.M. and run every 20 minutes until 2:00 A.M.
- Guests arriving after 2:00 A.M. should call the Hotel (847-292-9100) for pick-up.
- THE HOTEL SHUTTLE CENTER is located directly across the street from the Hilton O'Hare Lobby
- Follow the overhead signs for THE HOTEL SHUTTLE in the baggage claim area (lower level) of each domestic terminal to the nearest underground pedestrian walkway.
- Proceed to Elevator Center #3 or #4 and press the button marked SHUTTLE
- Take the elevator to the 1st floor and exit the Hilton Lobby
- The Doubletree Hotel Shuttle will pick-up at DOOR #3. (The Hotel Shuttle will have both Doubletree O'Hare and the Embassy Suites O'Hare logos.)
- For International arrivals, the shuttle will stop at Terminal 5, upon request by calling 847-292-9100 upon arrival.

Parking is complimentary to guests staying at the Doubletree Hotel ---

Park at the Embassy Suites garage which is adjacent to the Doubletree Hotel.

If you park with the valet in front of the Hotel you will be charged \$20.00 USD a day.
